Q: Is there a link between RLS and frozen or repeatedly numbed lower extremities?

A: The symptoms may be signs of **peripheral neuropathy*** and may occur at the same time as RLS but may also be present during the day and occur independently from RLS or PLMW (periodic limb movements in wakefulness). The patient should consult with a neurologist specializing in RLS.
